Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you had a lovely Easter break and are looking forward to a fun half term. We are starting this term off with our topic 'The Great Outdoors'. This booklet is to inform you of what your child will be learning this half term. There are also some questions included to help your children to extend their learning at home.

Mathematics (M)

This term we will be carrying on with number work, thinking about numbers to 20 and beyond and how to represent them. We will also be looking spatial reasoning.

Can you count to 20?

Literacy (L)

In Literacy this half term, we will be looking at a range of stories based on plants and insects, especially the stories written by Eric Carle. We will be doing lots of sentence building, making sure that we have finger spaces between words and checking that our writing makes sense.

Can you write a sentence about 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSED)

During this term we will be recapping how we treat each other in school and how we deal with our emotions. We will also think about staying safe around water.

What can you do if you feel worried or scared?

Communication and Language (CL)

This term we will carry on doing lots of speaking and listening activities as a whole class and in small groups. We will be sharing our ideas and thoughts during Circle Time. We will also be listening to a range of texts including stories, poetry, and non-fiction to help develop our vocabulary.

Physical Development (PD)

In PD we will be providing the children with lots of opportunities to demonstrate their fine and gross motor skills. On Thursday's, we will have PE with Miss Boon. She will be teaching multi-skills.
