Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you had a lovely half term break and are looking forward to an exciting half term. This half term we will be learning about the seaside and underwater creatures. This booklet is to inform you of what your child will be learning this term. There are also some questions included to help your children to extend their learning at home.

Mathematics (M)

This term we will be carrying on with number work, thinking about doubling, sharing, grouping and odd and even numbers. We will also be looking at patterns and spatial reasoning.

Can you share biscuits between your family members so that they have the same amount in each group?

Literacy (L)

In Literacy this half term, we will be looking at a range of stories based on the beach and under the water. We will be doing lots of sentence writing, making sure that we are using full stops and capital letters.

Can you write a sentence about something that you did in school today?

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSED)

During this term we will be recapping how we treat each other in school and thinking about the school rules. We will also be learning about being safe in the sun and when around water.

Can you tell a grown up how to stay safe in the sun?

Communication and Language (CL)

This term we will be doing lots of speaking and listening activities as a whole class and in small groups. We will be sharing our ideas and thoughts during Circle Time. We will also be listening to a range of texts including stories, poetry and non-fiction to help develop our vocabulary.

Physical Development (PD)

In PD we will be providing the children with lots of opportunities to demonstrate their fine and gross motor skills such as cutting and writing activities. On Wednesdays, we will have PE with Mrs Jarvis. She will be teaching Athletics. Please send your child to school in their sports clothes on Wednesday only.

Understanding the World (UW)
