Mathematics

- 1. Punctuate dialogue correctly varying the position of the reporting phrase. E.g. Mrs Gregory said, "Please wash your hands."

 - "Wash your hands," said Mrs Gregory, "and don't forget to dry them thoroughly."
- 2. Know the difference between 'their', 'they're' and 'there'. 'Their' is a possessive pronoun, 'there' is a contraction of 'they are', and 'there' shows position.
- 3. Use modal verbs to show possibility. Know the effect of using 'will', 'should' and 'could' in a sentence.
