We are starting this half term with our theme 'Let's Celebrate'. This booklet is to inform you of what your child will be learning this term. There are also some questions included to help your children to extend their learning at home.

Mathematics (M)

This term we will be carrying on with number work, learning about numbers to 5. We will also be thinking about 2D shapes including, squares, rectangles, triangles, and circles.

Literacy (L)

In Literacy this half term, we will be looking at a range of celebrations that are based on historical stories such as the Christmas story. We will be doing lots of word building using the new sounds we are learning in Phonics and we will also spend lots of time learning how to write simple sentences.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSED)
