1. Please use an A4 piece of paper
2. You can use paint, coloured pencils, crayons, felt tip pens or you can design your poster on the computer.
3. Make your design simple but effective with eye catching vibrant colours.
4. You can use pictures, wording or a mixture of both.
5. Include a safety header on your poster – these are some suggestions you can use:



- Drive with care
- Please park responsibly
- Please slow down
- Caution! Children crossing
- Please respect our school
- Think before you park. Stopping here puts a child in danger
- Please do not park on the yellow lines
- Or you can think of your own heading! Can you make it rhyme?

6. Remember to include your name and class on your design
7. All entries must be handed to your class teacher or the school office by **Friday 8th November.**
