1. **How many days in a year?** 365

5. **What type of words are used in a 3 bad dash sentence?** 3 negative emotions.

Science: Humans: Birth to old age

2. **What is a gestation period?** Gestation is the period of development during the carrying of an embryo, and later foetus, inside viviparous animals
3. **Name 2 ways that babies grow** Taller/ length, weight – various other answers (teeth, hair etc.)
4. **What causes puberty to begin?** Hormones!
5. **What is an average life expectancy?** The approximate amount of time a human/ animal is expected to live for.

R.E: Hinduism - Diwali

1. **What does Diwali mean?** Row of lights
2. **What month is Diwali normally celebrated?** October or November
3. **How long does Diwali last?** 5 Days
4. **Name two things that people do to get ready for Diwali?** Sweep/clean the house, make Rangoli patterns
5. **From which country did Hinduism originate?** India

PSHE: Puberty
